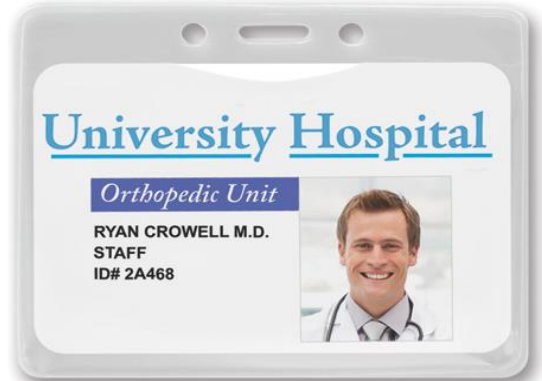

ID Badges, Badge Holders and credit cards are often forgotten when it comes to germ carriers. Here's how to easily clean these items and sanitize them for frequent use.

- Be sure to wash hands before and after this process.
- Remove ID Badge from Badge Holder.
- Use a paper towel or lint-free towel – either will do.
- Add rubbing alcohol, any household cleanser, disinfectant wipe or diluted soap (add water) to towel.
- Lightly rub both ID Badge and Badge Holder. If using soap and water, soak & rub for 20 seconds, then rinse.
- Dry with clean paper towel or allow to air dry.
- ID Badges are durable and can withstand most cleaning products. Be cautious using bleach as it may remove some of the printed text.



## For credit cards:

- First, wipe the card with a damp towel.
- Take a rubber eraser and gently rub it along the magnetic strip. These two simple steps will help remove built-up grime.
- You can also use an anti-bacterial wipe instead of a damp towel to clean the card.
- In addition, we recommend that you wash your hands often to help avoid spreading germs onto your personal belongings.
